The Liturgy: Past and Future: This fall, the diocese will begin a program of catechesis on the liturgy, including the development of the liturgy over the centuries. Four 90 minute sessions are planned for the fall, four for the winter of 2011, and final sessions for the fall of 2011. All of these sessions will be designed to lead us into the new translations of the Missal, which are scheduled to begin in Advent, 2011. The sessions will include a DVD presentation, in addition to reading material. The hope of the diocese is that these sessions can be done in small groups, in the homes of parishioners. At this point, we are asking parishioners to consider being a host for a small group, or being a small group facilitator (**mandatory** training will be offered for facilitators.) If you are interested in being a host or facilitator, sign up in church, parish hall or call the office. The first sessions can be held at any time between September and November. You will be hearing more about these sessions in the upcoming weeks. Thanks to all of those who have already signed up.

If you would like to schedule independent study work or makeup work for your child who is unable to attend on Sunday AM, please register in the gathering area after Mass this weekend.
