Fr. Auggie's Reflection - Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Prv 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31; Ps 128; 1 Thes 5:1-6; Mt 25:14-30

From the Gospel:

I will give you great responsibilities.

Come, share your master's joy.'

Reflection:

At first, it might seem strange for the master of the servants to invite them to share in his joy immediately after promising great responsibility. Yet, when we realize that the master represents Christ, then the invitation and promise of joy make sense. While all faithful Christians look forward to the joy of God's Kingdom, we can experience that joy here on this earth when we put God's gifts to us at the service of others. God's joy is in our salvation, in which He pours out grace upon us and leads us to Him. When you and I use God's gifts to help another person find God, either in our prayerful encounters or corporal works of mercy, we have the opportunity to experience some of God's joy in our own acts of charity. The greater we take on the responsibility of ministering to others in God's name, the more we come to know the love God has for us.
