Fr. Auggie's Reflection - 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year B

1 Samuel 3: 3b-10, 19; Ps. 40: 2-4, 7-10; 1 Cor. 6: 13c-15a, 17-20; John 1: 35-42

From John's Gospel:

John the Baptist said to two of his disciples, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus.

Reflection:

Notice the trust of John's disciples: They are willing to leave him immediately for Christ...and John is willing to let them. This should surprise us, as a disciple is more than simply a student. A disciple takes every aspect of the teacher's life and makes it his own. The master cares for his disciples as his own children. This is a life-long relationship, until the disciple is ready to gather his own disciples and teach them. So, for a disciple to part from his master and unite himself to another master normally is cause for alarm. But, not when we realize the purpose of John the Baptist: to prepare the way for the Lord. John's disciples follow John along the path leading to the Messiah. John's path is to prepare the way for, and lead others to Christ. If his disciples truly follow in his way, then they too will follow Christ and make straight the paths to God for others. While we are all disciples of Jesus Christ, following in His way, let us consider our calling also to be like John the Baptist, announcing Christ's presence and opening the path to Christ for others, especially those most dear to us.

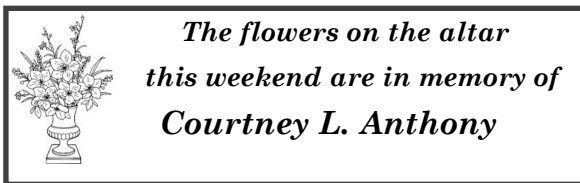
