Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP

From today's Gospel reading:

This is the time of fulfillment.  
The kingdom of God is at hand.  
Repent, and believe the gospel.

Reflection:

In Jesus' language "repentance" means to make 180° change of direction in our lives. He challenges us to rethink our notion of who God is and how God acts towards us in the light of our sins. In Jesus, God is breaking into our worlds of isolation and indifference and calling us to faith in Christ. In sum, repentance asks that we make a complete turnaround in our lives towards God.

So we ask ourselves:

What redirection and big change must I make in my life?

What will be the first step towards that kind of change?
