From today's Philippians reading:

the prize of God's upward calling, in Christ Jesus.

Reflection by Jude Siciliano, O.P.:

Paul knew the work of rebirth was not yet complete in himself. Which we too have become aware of again this Lent—more needs to be done in us. We know this – Christ knows it too. He is not ready to condemn, but because of our union in him, Christ promises to finish the work of salvation begun in us.

So we ask ourselves:

- ◇ What do you think Paul means by "the prize of God's upward calling?"
- ◇ What "higher calling" have we heard this Lent for our lives?
