Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

Eternal life is the deep life that begins now for those who hear and act on Jesus' words. It provides: solid ground for us to stand on during life's storms; peace even amid great change; forgiveness each time we ask; healing for life's wounds. We have passed from death to life. "Eternal life" is both a gift now for believers and a promise that will not be fully realized until the future.
