#### **RECIPE**

St. Peter's Sandwich Ministry Sandwiches

Yield: 24 sandwiches

2 loaves of white bread

24 slices of thick sliced bologna (roughly 3 packages)

24 slices of yellow American cheese

24 clear sandwich plastic bags (no ziplocks please)

1 standard brown grocery bag (any sturdy bag that can be sealed or stapled closed)

EACH SANDWICH: 2 slices of bread, one slice of bologna, one slice cheese... EASY

Then insert each individual, whole sandwich in a plastic sandwich bag.

- Stack the bagged sandwiches neatly in the standard brown grocery bag.
- Fold & staple the bag closed.
- Be sure to add to the front of the bag: your name/quantity of sandwiches/date
