From today's Deuteronomy reading:

has directed all your journeying in the desert...."

Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

"Remember," Moses instructs us. And so we do. We recall how the bread of life has fed us day by day, often in ways we did not recognize at first. But now we do and now, at this community meal, we remember and give thanks.

So we ask ourselves:

HYMN 1017 (1, 2) O LIVING BREAD FROM HEAVEN Aurelia

In 1264, Thomas Aquinas was commissioned to write hymns and prayers for a new feast - Corpus Christi. Texts still sung today include *Pange lingua* (Hymn 579) on Holy Thursday, and *Panis Angelicus* (Hymn 1024). Like Easter and Pentecost, Corpus Christi has a *Sequence Hymn* ("Praise, O Zion", Hymn 677), penned by Thomas and sung now to a melody named for him. Note: our stained glass windows flanking the Altar area show St. Thomas (*right*) and Blessed Imelda (*left*), two Dominican saints closely associated with the Eucharist.
