Acts 2: 1-11; Ps. 104; Romans 8: 8-17; John 20: 19-23

From today's Gospel reading:

On the evening of that first day of the week,
when the doors were locked, where the disciples were,
for fear of the Jewish authorities,

Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them,

"Peace be with you....As the Father has sent me, so I send you."

Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

Fear can have power over us and keep us from attempting any change at all in our lives; afraid to let go of what we know and have adapted to, for what is untried and unknown. The disciples behind locked doors were gathered in fear. But Jesus' gift of the Spirit freed them to unlock their lives and take their faith in the risen Lord into the world with courage.

So we ask ourselves:

† How has fear locked me up and kept me from making important changes in my life?

† With Christ's Spirit, what can I do to "unlock" the door and be free?

HYMN 772 (1 & 6) O HOLY SPIRIT, BY WHOSE BREATH

~ LITURGY NOTES ~

Pentecost (Greek: *pente* = 50) concludes the *Great 50 Days of Easter*, ending with an ancient double *Alleluia* chant, first sung at Easter Vigil. The scriptures are proclaimed in various languages to reflect the universal nature of the Church and to recall the first Pentecost as recounted in today's reading from Acts. Along with Easter and Corpus Christi, Pentecost possesses a *Sequence Hymn* (before the Gospel), a medieval poem originally set to chant. We sing a metrical version, "Come, Holy Spirit", set to a French chant (*O Filii et Filiae*), associated for centuries with this Paschal season and the source of our Easter tide Gospel Acclamation.
