Why Does God Hide Himself? with fr. Benedikt Grube, O.P.

Friar Benedikt Grube, O.P. will present an Adult Faith Formation session entitled, "Why does God hide himself?" from 9:45 to 10:45 a.m. Fr. Benedikt has a Ph.D. in Philosophy (University of Texas at Austin) and MA in Philosophy and German Literature (University of Tübingen, Germany). He was a lecturer in Philosophy in Texas and Erfurt, Germany before entering the Order of Preachers, and is currently studying theology in Vienna.
