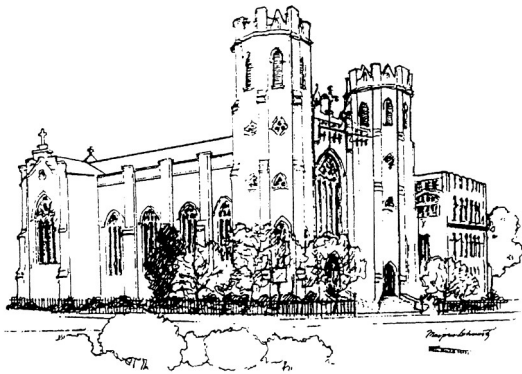

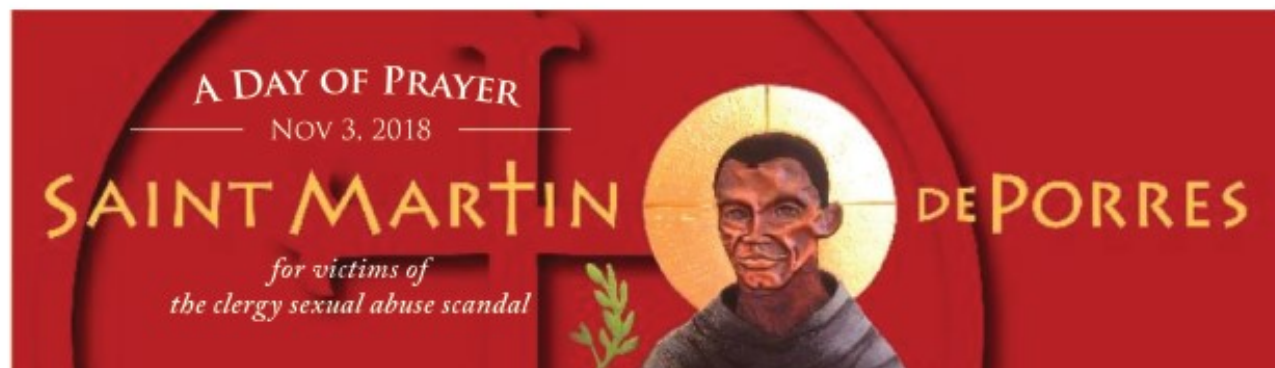


Jon Leonetti's "A Surge of the Heart" Mission
