Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

peace of comfort and the well-being the world desires. Following him

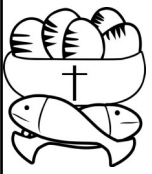

~ LITURGICAL NOTES: Singing the Psalms, Part III ~

In addition to the *responsorial* format as sung most Sundays after the First Reading, psalm texts (the 'Songbook of the Bible') have inspired *rhymed* versions which can be sung by all to a *metrical* tune. Many of these hymns are shared with other Christian churches. Hymn 952 "All People that on Earth Do Dwell" is a rhymed text based on Psalm 100; for centuries it has been sung to a 16th c. tune named for that psalm: *Old 100th or Hundredth*. Similarly, today's closing hymn is a setting of Psalm 148 (Hymn 949 - "Praise the Lord of Heaven"), paired with a cheerful French folk tune.
