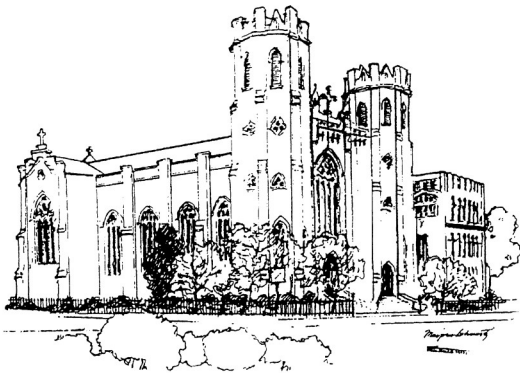

**Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:**

It's a statement that can stir thanksgiving in our hearts as we offer today's Eucharist.

## ~ LITURGICAL NOTES: Singing the Psalms ~

Known as the 'Songbook of the Bible', the Psalms can be sung in various formats, such as responsorial, antiphonal/alternation, and metrical (Hymn). The role of the Cantor is especially important in the *responsorial format* so that all may sing the Response. Hymns allow metrical (poetical) translations to be sung by everyone to familiar tunes: "O God, Our Help in Ages Past" (Psalm 90) to *St. Anne*; "We Sing the Mighty Power of God" (Psalm 103) to *Mozart*. The tune name may refer to its creator, or a place associated with that composer, e.g. *St. Anne* was the London church where William Croft was organist when he wrote this well-known melody.
