Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

The lepers' cure came as they traveled. Perhaps we too realize that the healings we need, the physical, emotional and spiritual ones, don't happen all at once, but occur as we travel, step by step, through life. Isn't that the way most of us come to wholeness – step by step – with the help of trusted family, friends, counselors, teachers, etc. who help us experience cleansing and renewal? Do we "realize," as the cured leper did, that it is Jesus who is the source of our healing?

So we ask ourselves:

- Can I name some of the healings that have happened in my life through faith?
- How have I returned thanks to God for those healings?

~ Note from the LOFT ~

Last Sunday, at 11 AM Mass, a surprise 'voice' was added on our Opening Hymn. As we sang "Hail, Holy Queen, Enthroned Above", our wonderful pipe organ had a 'cipher' (a stuck note) - the first in many years. With almost 3,000 pipes, that's a very good track record! What causes a cipher? Like any musical instrument made of wood, humidity and extremes of temperature are factors. Furthermore, with pipes, small obstacles (ceiling plaster chunks, bugs) falling inside can clog up the mechanism controlling the stream of air and cause a constant sound! How does one fix a cipher? Often, turning the organ off and on can correct it. MANY thanks to our dedicated CHOIR for quickly and quietly re-locating to the Transept and continuing their ministry.
