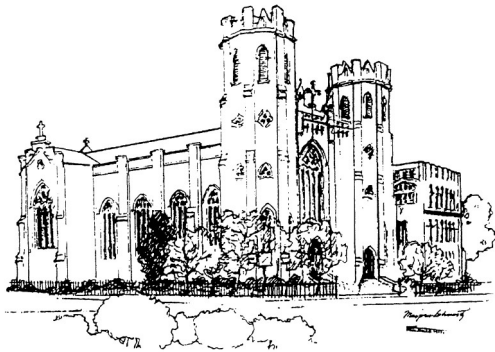

**1<sup>st</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT (A) March 1, 2020**

**Genesis 2: 7-9; 3: 1-7; Psalm 51; Romans 5: 12-19; Matthew 4: 1-11**

**From today's gospel:**

At that time Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. He fasted for forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was hungry. The tempter approached and said to him, "If you are the Son of God, command that these stones become loaves of bread." He said in reply, "It is written: *One does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.*"

**Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:**

*That day in the desert – could Jesus have changed stones into bread? Yes. Did he choose to do that? No. Well, not in the way the tempter wanted.*

*We recall the hard places in our lives when we met rocks on the road, when we stumbled, tripped and gotten hurt. To our surprise, we found strength and nourishment, sometimes in the most surprising places. Stones were turned into bread when we were in need.*

**We ask ourselves:**

- † *Can we name a personal desert period when God gave us strength and faith to see us through?*
- † *This Lent, how can I express my gratitude to God for the bread I received in hard times*
