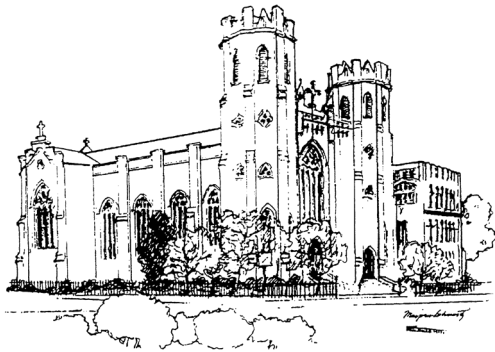

Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

*Thank God for Thomas! We're happy he was there to voice our rational doubts. We are also happy that the church, those new, Spirit-
animated disciples, didn't give up on their recalcitrant member. Let's
hope we modern Christians stay true to our call to be a forgiving com-
munity and a healing one for those hurting in spirit and body.*

- What current stumbling block currently limits a deeper faith in Jesus?
