Today we celebrate the Patronal feast of our parish, the Mother Church for Roman Catholics in West Tennessee. Founded in 1840, the Dominican Order was given charge of the parish in 1846. Although named in honor of both the “Prince of the Apostles” and the “Apostle to the Gentiles”, early historical accounts refer to the church simply as St. Peter’s. Both saints are depicted in the window above the High Altar, made by the Munich firm Franz Mayer and installed in 1899. They hold symbols traditionally associate with them: Peter: Keys – I will give to you the keys of the kingdom of heaven (Matthew 16:18) Paul: Sword and Scroll – many books of the New Testament are attributed to this saint, martyred by the sword.



Liturgical Music Notes:
Our Patronal Feast today!

What’s in a name? If referring to hymn tune names – a lot! Today’s Liturgy begins and ends with texts specifically tied to our patronal feast, but sung to melodies we know with other words. “By All Your Saints Still Striving” uses the sturdy tune *St. Theodulph*, sung every Palm Sunday. The tune’s name acknowledges the 8th c. author of “All Glory, Laud, and Honor”. At the end of Mass we sing “Go to the World!” – a modern poem of discipleship set to the tune *Sine Nomine* – first wedded to “For All the Saints”, thus further alluding to those we honor on this great feast.

PLANNING TO COME TO ST. PETER

- **To reserve a pew:** Call our office, 901-527-8282 Mon. – Thurs., 8AM - 4PM, and Fri., 8AM – 1PM or email secretary@stpeterchurch.org. Note: *No reservation is required for Daily Mass, which we celebrate Mon.– Fri., 12:05PM in the Main Church.*

COMING TO ST. PETER

- Masks are **always required**.
- Upon arrival, maintain six (6) feet of distance between people who are not members of your household.

DURING MASS

- Please remain in your pew at all times, unless you need the restroom.
- The quiet room and nursery **ARE NOT** available.
- Ushers will collect the offertory, using long-handled baskets to ensure as little physical contact as possible.
- For Communion, **stay in your pew**. A priest will bring the host to you. The cup will not be offered at this time. We will ensure those who need low-gluten hosts receive them.
- Receiving Communion **is the only time** anyone is permitted to remove masks.

Let's practice the 3 Rs:

- 1) Remove, 2) Receive, 3) Replace.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF MASS

- **Ushers will go to each pew and direct you to leave** – from the back of the church to the front.
- Please do not make a dash for the door.
- Please do not linger in front of the church. The priests will not be interacting with people on the front steps.

BETWEEN THE MASSES

- Our building will be locked between Masses for cleaning. Unfortunately, no other facilities will be open on our property during this time.
