

18th SUNDAY (A) August 2, 2020

Isaiah 55: 1-3; Psalm 145; Rom. 8: 35,37-39; Matthew 14: 13-21

From today's Gospel reading:

Taking the five loaves and two fish, and looking up to heaven, Jesus said the blessing, broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples, who in turn gave them to the crowds.

Reflection by Jude Siciliano, OP:

Jesus saw the hungry crowd and with the loaves and fish his disciples offered, he fed them. While we might receive comfort knowing that our inner hungers are fed at our eucharistic meal, let's not just "spiritualize" today's gospel.

Let's remember that Jesus' pity extended to the crowd's physical needs that he saw when he disembarked from the boat. Matthew tells us, "He was moved with pity for them and he cured their sick," and, with the disciples' help, he fed their hunger.

So, we ask ourselves:

- *What hunger do I bring to this Eucharist today that I turn to Jesus to feed?*
- *Who are the hungry I am hearing Jesus invite me to feed – with his help?*

LITURGICAL MUSIC NOTES ORDINARY XVIII



Our Liturgy (Gr. *leitourgia* = *work of the people*) is composed of many elements - spoken and sung prayers, ritual movements such as kneeling, standing, signing of the Cross, processions. Music appropriately paired with some movements can enrich them: the Sprinkling Rite, Presentation of Gifts, Communion procession. Other musical settings, such as the Mass Ordinary and Hymns, stand 'on their own' to unite many voices and hearts into one. During the pandemic, some rituals have changed, with ritual music being adapted to shorter (or no) processions, and less congregational singing at Communion (when masks are removed to receive).

Public Mass Notes

COMING TO ST. PETER

- Masks are **always required**.
- Upon arrival, maintain six (6) feet of distance between people who are not members of your household.

DURING MASS

- Please remain in your pew at all times, unless you need the restroom.
- The quiet room and nursery **ARE NOT** available.
- Ushers will collect the offertory, using long-handled baskets to ensure as little physical contact as possible.
- For Communion, **stay in your pew**. A priest will bring the host to you. The cup will not be offered at this time. We will ensure those who need low-gluten hosts receive them.
- Receiving Communion **is the only time** anyone is permitted to remove masks.

Let's practice the 3 Rs:
1) Remove, 2) Receive, 3) Replace.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF MASS

- **Ushers will go to each pew and direct you to leave** – from the back of the church to the front.
- Please do not make a dash for the door.
- Please do not linger in front of the church. The priests will not be interacting with people on the front steps.

BETWEEN THE MASSES

- Our building will be locked between Masses for cleaning. Unfortunately, no other facilities will be open on our property during this time.

Assisted Listening Devices
 St. Peter's has 8 assisted listening devices to help those who are hard of hearing. Just ask an usher for headphones when you arrive at Mass!

Dispensation Extension—Bishop Talley has extended the dispensation from attending Mass until September 4. It is up to each parishioner to decide what is the best plan for you and/or your family. All of our Masses will continue to be streamed online, www.stpeterchurch.org/live-and-recorded-masses/.
