Solemnity of All Saints – November 1, 2020

Revelation 7:2-4, 9-14 | Psalm 24 | 1 John 3:1-3 | Matthew 5:1-12a

From today’s reading from the Book of Revelation:

“Amen. Blessing and glory, wisdom and thanksgiving, honor, power, and might be to our God forever and ever. Amen.”

Reflection by Br. Carlos Salas, OP:

“We glorify you with the multitude of Saints and Angels, as with one voice of praise we acclaim.” These are the words that the presiding priest prays at the celebration of the Eucharist to invite the rest of us gathered to sing praise to our God. In the *Sanctus*, we are singing and praying with the entire Body of Christ. We join the choirs of angels and all the saints: those whom we know—like our patrons, Sts. Peter, Dominic, and Martin de Porres—and those we don’t recognize as saints but are enjoying in the beatific vision—very likely people that we met. God desires sanctity for every single one of us, “we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.” Thus, though we are still on earth and bound by our spacetime limitations, Christ left us the Eucharist so that we may have access to heaven—to Him—through Communion and participation in the heavenly liturgy.

Something to think about:

- The path to sainthood is not like a bread recipe that you follow and *poof* you’re a saint. Instead, it is the constant nurturing of the relationship with our Lord, which requires self-denial before Him and before others. “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven.”
- We all share in the universal call to holiness, “Be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect” (CCC 2013; Matt 5:48). Answering this call is something that we simply can’t do alone. We must rely on the strength that our Lord offers us in the Sacraments and our prayer. How may I approach Him today with this desire to be holy?

Introduction to Iconography
Thursday, November 12th at 7-8 PM

Sr. Rebecca, a nun of New Skete monastery in Cambridge, New York, (<https://newskete.org>) will provide a one-hour presentation on painted iconography in the Byzantine and Russian traditions. Painted icons are a central part of the catholic tradition as exemplified in Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, Coptic, and other eastern Christian Churches.

Sr. Rebecca began her studies in iconography at the Russian Institute of Paris in 1976 with Fr. Egon Sendler, S.J., a world famous expert in the history of icons and in the technical aspects of icon production. In addition to teaching iconography and painting icons, Sr. Rebecca uses iconography in lectures and retreats presented in the USA and abroad.
